OUR LADY HELP OF CHRISTIANS: AUSTRALIA'S PATRONESS

The history of this title for the Blessed Virgin Mary goes way **back to the 200's. A papyrus** was found with a prayer directed to Mary. It is still popularly known as the *Sub Tuum Praesidium* in Latin: *"We fly to thy protection, O Holy Mother of God, despise not our prayers in our necessities, and deliver us from all danger, O Glorious and Blessed Virgin."* Anyone who has been educated by the **Marist Brothers** in Australia, and probably around the world, would have sung it in Latin at their Masses. I know **Marcellin College, Randwick** still do...and the boys lift the roof with their singing.

Another early prayer was composed by **St John Chrysostom who died in 407**, having used the title in a homily.

The next major occasion for Mary to be prayed to under this title was at the time of **Battle of Lepanto in 1571 when Christian forces known as the Holy Leage – with forces from Spain, the Papal States of Italy and other Italian States, and the navy of Venice - faced off with the Ottoman, Muslim forces intent on conquering Europe.**

France, the Holy Roman Empire and many others had no help to offer the defence of Europe, consumed by internal conflicts between Catholics and Protestants. The feeling of inevitable defeat on the part of the Catholic powers was immense.

As the fleet sailed out, **Pope Pius V ordered the churches of Rome remain open for prayer day and night, encouraging the faithful to petition the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary through the recitation of the Rosary.** The battle itself was bloody. Some 7,500 Catholic combatants and 20-30,000 Ottoman combatants were killed. It was a decisive Catholic victory, and the Ottoman fleet was destroyed. Amid the tragic loss of human life, some good news was that thousands of Christian slaves, chained below decks as rowers for the Ottoman ships were freed – one of whom was Cervantes, the great Spanish poet of *Don Quixote* fame.

Pope Pius V, as witnessed to by his secretary, in Prayer, three days before the news of the victory arrived in Rome, told his secretary that the Catholic forces had won the battle. The secretary duly noted the day and hour the Pope "knew". And, it corresponded with the victory itself. (Thanks Br Rory for this information.) Pius V established the feast of Our Lady of Victory on October 7, later renamed Our Lady of the Rosary, and attributed the victory to Mary's intercession. Our Lady Help of Christians derives from the same source.

In our own **Great South Land of the Holy Spirit, Australia**, the Feast by then known also as Our Lady Help of Christians, was proclaimed as our Patroness in **the First Provincial Council of Australia in Sydney in 1844.** The Penal Colony of Sydney was only established in 1788. 10% of the convicts were Catholic with many from Ireland or of Irish descent.

We acknowledge the traditional owners the Gadigal Clans of the Eora Nation, who cared for this land for thousands of years and their descendants who have maintained these Spiritual connections and traditions.

Three convict priests also arrived in 1800 sent because of suspicion they were involved in an insurrection in Ireland. One, Fr Dixon, was given a conditional pardon and allowed to celebrate the sacraments in Sydney, Liverpool and Parramatta on successive Sundays beginning in 1803. However, this was revoked after the Irish lead Castle Hill Insurrection in 1804 and all three convict priests were deported. The next priest to arrive was an Irish Cisterican, Fr Jeremiah O'Flynn. However, he did not have Government permission and after some hide and seek he was deported but not before he left the Blessed Sacrament with the Dempsey Family in their house in The Rocks. Catholics gathered to recite the Rosary there. You may recall that the Stinson family of OLR are direct descendants of this Dempsey family – commemorated last year.

The first authorised priests, Frs Therry and Connolly, arrived in 1820. Fr Connolly went immediately to Tasmania, there being a large penal colony, harsh as always, at Port Arthur. And so, our uncertain beginnings were built up to the flourishing Church we see today, and we can thank Our Lady for her protection throughout. A hymn worth recovering is that written by the Australian poet, James McAuley, *Help of Christians Guard this Land....*

Prayer from the Mass for the 24 May, Mary, Help of Christians: "Almighty and ever-living God, who placed the love of Our Lady, Help of Christians in the hearts of those who brought the Catholic faith to these shores, grant, through her intercession, wisdom to our leaders and integrity to our citizens, so that, under her protection, Australia may know harmony, justice and peace. Through Our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen"




