Heart of Jesus, pray for us.

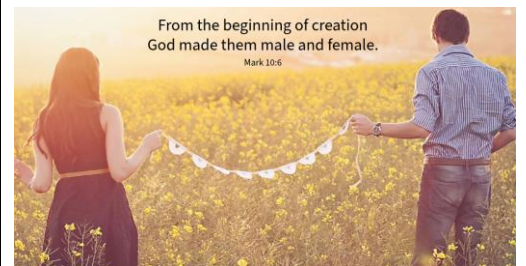
**ALL NIGHT ROSARY VIGIL AND ADORATION:**

## PPC Meeting #3 1 October 2024 Minutes

**Present:** Stephen Chiew, Marieanne Duncan, Diyana Mansour, Claude Khoury, Fr Peter. Special Guest: Edo Setiaprsojo

**Meeting opened with Prayer and N.T. Reading** followed by discussion based on *Integrity in Our Common Mission – National Code of Conduct for those exercising pastoral ministry in the dioceses of the Catholic Church in Australia*. Section 1.1 and 1.2 A *Culture of Safeguarding*. Some of the dot points: “think and act in the best interests of children; speak out when actions, behaviours, language, or environment may cause harm; embed effective safeguarding policies and practices at all levels of government and leadership...**Each PPC begins with an update on Safeguarding.**

### Business arising:

**Youth/Young Adults. Most of the meeting centred around Ministry for youth and young adults. Our guest, Edo Sutiaprsojo, spoke about his background and ministry with Youth and Young Adults in the Church.** He is a young family man with two small children and has recently moved to the Kensington area followed a process of prayerful discernment. He came to Sydney as a university student from Indonesia and got involved in the **Indonesian Catholic Community**. For the past 10 years he has been a member of the **Domus Cordis Community, a Covenanted Community based in Jakarta with an Australian community in the Ryde area**. The meetings are in Bahasa.

**Beginning in March this year, Edo has been leading a monthly youth-group in our Parish Hall in English, on the second Sunday of the month following the 9.30am Mass.** Currently there are 8 youth, and importantly, **4 young OLR adults who are being formed as team leaders**. They have games and ice-breakers to begin, and then selections from a Program called “Venture”. The Domus Cordis Community conduct “**Inspire**” youth/young adult gatherings. Teens are surveyed about the kinds of topics they would like to discuss. Groups are supervised at all times by adults. **Edo will address our Masses sometime after the School Holidays.** This presents a great opportunity for our Parish outreach to youth/young adults.

**Other Matters: Maintenance:** Noted that *Maria’s Kitchenette* is now finished – gives so much more cupboard space also for the office. Our thanks to Eka for the design and John Reis for a very fine job. John Reis will be asked to complete the **floor covering of the Foyer of the Hall; Trip hazards on the paths** around the Church, **steps** to be marked with treads; **Four areas of leaks in the Church. AV update** is underway with a new cupboard being constructed for the equipment. **A Building and Maintenance Meeting is to be scheduled for overall repairs** to mortar, windows, extra security lighting, and CCTV for the Sacristies and exterior of the Church.

**Items Noted: Overnight Adoration on Sunday-Monday 6-7 October Feast of OLR. Walk With Mary** through the Shrines in the Convent grounds, Cloister and Chapel on Sunday morning, October 20 October following the 9.30am Mass. It concludes with a **barbeque in the School Grounds**. Our thanks to Sarina and her co-workers for organising these events.

**Parish Magazine.** Fr Peter brought 5 Magazines from OLSH Randwick as examples of what we might do. However, he managed to misplace them – probably in the Recycle Bin with old newspapers! So, it remains a virtual program for the present but to be followed up by obtaining further copies of the OLSH Magazine. Notice of Further Archdiocesan Documentation to be studied: **A Draft Constitution for PPCs.**

**Meeting closed at 8.00pm.** One more meeting will be scheduled for the end of November – date to be determined.

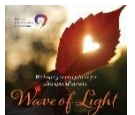
