It is a happy day then when we can admit that we are poor and vulnerable, weak and wounded and in need of nourishment.

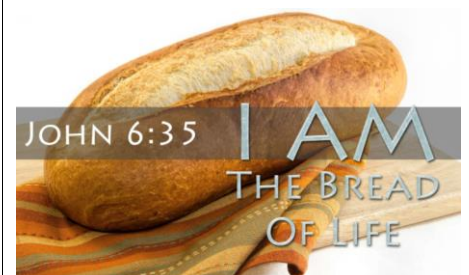
For it is in our emptiness that we are filled.

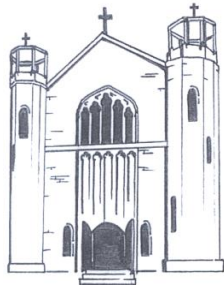

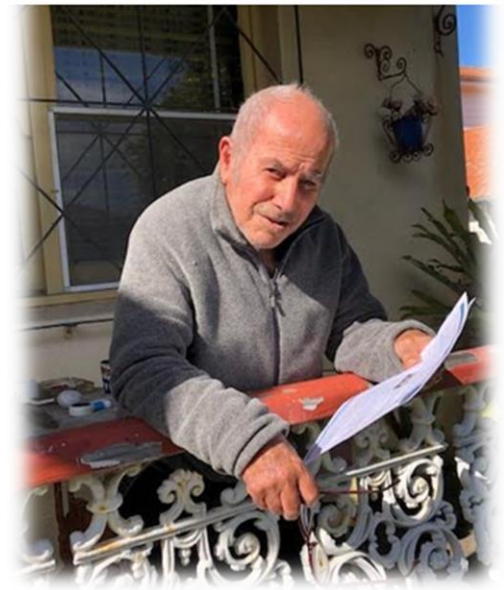
