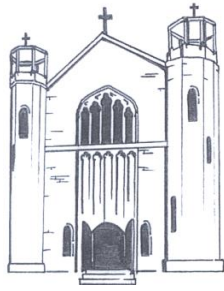

# Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary

The feast day of Our Lady of the Rosary is on 7 October and we will be celebrating this event at the 9.30am mass online on Sunday 10 October.

As we still cannot be physically present, we are continuing with our special planned arrangement which seeks to give our community an option to physically connect with the church on our parish's feast day.

A candlelit Mass will be delivered online, and you can participate by purchasing a candle as part of a gift package or individually. These will be available to take home at a later date and also make wonderful gifts for loved ones.

## Option 1: Gift Package (\$60)

This package includes a beautiful handmade wooden icon (A5 size) with the image of Our Lady, a set of Rosary Beads and a candle with our Parish's logo. These will be placed on the pew during mass, along with your name and blessed by Fr Terry. We are limited to 100 packages.



## Option 2: Light a Candle (donation of your choice)

The candle will be lit during the feast day mass and blessed by Fr Terry.



## How to purchase

1. Make an online payment to the church through BPoint and select "Other" as the payment type (Bill Code) (<https://www.bpoint.com.au/pay/kensingtonparish>).
2. For the reference, type "G" for the Gift Package or "C" for Light a Candle, along with the name you would like to have on the pew. For example, "GSmith" or "CSmith".

Payment needs to be made by 7 October to allow time to organise.

Net proceeds will be split between the first and second collection. This will also help our church rebuild funds to meet regular expenses for the upkeep of our church and parish.

**We hope this helps our community feel more physically connected during these times and look forward to when we can all meet in person again.**

### WRITE TO YOUR LOCAL MP AHEAD OF EXPECTED PARLIAMENTARY DEBATE ON EUTHANASIA

NSW Parliament is set to resume on 12 October and Independent MP Alex Greenwich is likely to table his euthanasia bill that day.
