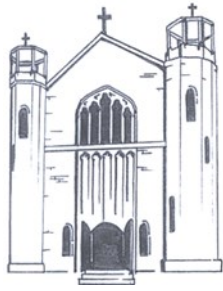
Calm in the storm

“Two years ago, after living for many months in a very conflictive situation, I felt utterly drained and depressed. I kept crying out to the Lord, but things did not seem to be getting any better. In the end I was so full of despair that I could no longer believe the tide was ever going to turn. It did not help that I kept blaming myself for being unable to cope with what seemed an insoluble problem.

In this state of exhaustion and despair I was strolling through the countryside one afternoon, feeling unable to continue. I had not slept for weeks and had no energy left to struggle on. It was like being on a sinking boat, with the storm raging around me and the waves ready to swallow me. I felt I was near drowning.

Then, all of a sudden, although things seemed so bad that they could hardly have become worse, I was invaded by deep peace. God was there, an overwhelming and incredibly loving Presence, life-giving but at the same time demanding. God’s love does not pamper us, it challenges us to grow. I was perfectly aware of the challenges ahead of me. I was still feeling very fragile and my situation was no better than before. But I was granted the courage to turn around and trust that God was about to give me a new and better future – and the strength to do my own part to work for change.” (Elizabeth)
