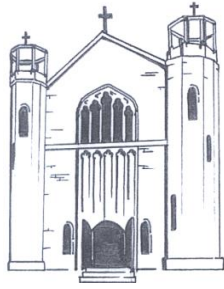

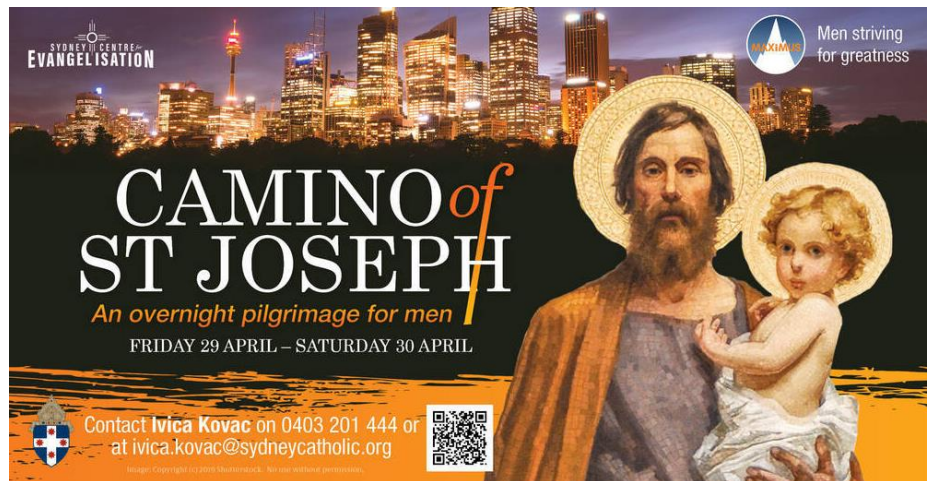
Abuse is a crime. The appropriate people to deal with a crime are the police.
