## GREATER SYDNEY COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

You will be aware that the NSW Premier has announced tightened restrictions for the City of Sydney, Randwick, Woollahra and Waverly Local Government Areas (LGAs) today.

From 11:59 pm today until at least 11:59 pm on 2 July 2021, residents of, or people whose usual place of work is in, the four LGAs must stay at home unless they have an essential reason to leave home.

Essential reasons include:

- Shopping for food or other essential goods and services;
- Medical care or compassionate needs;
- Exercise outdoors in groups of 10 or fewer;
- Essential work, or education, where you cannot work or study from home.

The government has advised residents across the broader Greater Sydney should also limit unnecessary activity and avoid large gatherings in coming days.

While places of public worship were not expressly mentioned in today's announcement, we understand the above restrictions to mean that churches in the affected LGAs must close, parish priests and residents at the parishes in these 4 LGAs must stay at home and staff who ordinarily work at the parishes must also stay at home even if they reside outside the 4 LGAs.

Residents who live or work in the four LGAs have been issued a stay-at-home order as the COVID-19 outbreak continues to spread.

**As we are located in one of the LGAs, OLR Church will be closed for the next 7 days - NO MASS (unless advice to the contrary is received). The Parish office will also be closed but you can make contact by phone or email.**
